Suffolk County Council - Cllr Fleming gave her report which is appended to the minutes

Mid Suffolk District Council – Cllr Burn reported that, as a one off, the District Councillors were going to have a Locality Award to be set aside for community benefits. Any organisation can apply to the fund and applications had to be made by 18 January 2016. Further details of the fund and how to apply can be obtained by contacting District Councillor Burn.

<u>Suffolk Police</u> – a report provided by PCSO Faulkner, which detailed one crime in the parish since the beginning of October, was read by the Clerk.

A parishioner asked for the Commons Co-ordinator reports on be published on the website. *Action: Clerk.*A parishioner reported that the Footpath Sign on Mellis Road was being knocked over when the verges were trimmed and could it be reinstated on footpath side of road and not the opposite side. The Clerk explained this was an issue for Suffolk County Council Footpaths department but she would duly report the matter to them. *Action: Clerk.* 

A parishioner asked if he would be able to comment when agenda item 7B was reached. The Chairman granted this request.

- 7. The Common
- a) Report from the Commons Co-ordinator Cllr A Colchester had provided a report which was noted and appended to the minutes for information. .
- b) Three quotations for <u>ditching clearance and removal of Black Thorn</u> from the roadside near the rail embankment were considered. A parishioner expressed his opinion that the habitat in this area is unusual and there were specific birds nesting there. It was explained that the whole area was not being cleared, but just a strip from the road side. It was agreed to award the work to contractor A at a cost of £210.00 including VAT.

A discussion took place on clearing the culverts near to the railway bridge also took place and a parishioner advised the Parish Council to liaise with Network Rail as he felt one of the culverts may have been intentionally blocked.

c) To consider parishioners' response to request for permission to <u>cut back a bough of the Horse Chestnut Tree</u> <u>overhanding Little Green</u>. Councillors explained that a request had been made to cut one low bough from the tree in front of Chestnut Farm. The Clerk relayed the advice the Mid Suffolk Tree Officer had provided. It was agreed to send another letter explaining that that the Parish Council would like to remove this one bough as the grass could

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not be cut with the bough handing there and it is the responsibility of the Parish Council, under the HLS agreement, to cut and maintain the grass.

8. To consider the <u>planting plan and cost for trees at the Rail Embankment</u> (as per AMCO funding). A quotation from a local nursery to supply trees, stakes and guards was considered. Councillors discussed how there was a limited area the trees could be planted in and it was agreed to reconsider how the money may be spent more effectively within the parish. *Action: Agenda next meeting.*
